

RECORD OF THE PORCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, LEWIS COUNTY, IDAHO

October Term

First Day

October 4, 2010

The Board of Lewis County Commissioners met in regular session with Carroll A. Keith, Chairman; Charles E. Doty and Don Davis, Members; and Cathy Larson, Clerk, present.

Commissioner Keith moved to adopt the increased fees for the Assessor and Treasurer and the restructure of the solid waste fees as follows:

Assessor: Mailing fee for Department of Motor Vehicle from 50 cents to 75 cents per registration and Department of Motor Vehicle Administration Fee from \$2.50 to \$3.00 per registration.

Treasurer: Notice of Pending Issue from \$300.00 to \$400.00 per parcel.

Solid Waste Fee Restructure on a per year basis: Business with large roll off - \$278.92; Business with home dispenser - \$91.78; Parks - \$278.92; Schools - \$278.92; City shops & offices - \$278.92; Churches - \$30.00; Church homes - \$97.78; Non-profit halls - \$30.00; Hotels/Motels – Business rate + \$5.00 per unit; Apartments – Business rate + \$10.00 per unit; Tax Exempt Entities - \$91.78
Commissioner Davis seconded the motion and a unanimous ballot was cast.

The Board reviewed the polling places for the General Election and set them as follows: **Nezperce Precinct** – Eller Building; **East and West Kamiah Precincts** – Emergency Service Building; **Craigmont Precinct** – City Hall; **Winchester Precinct** – CraigMountain Senior Citizens Center.

Dave Hasz, Emergency Management, met to discuss various items.

He presented a proposal for a Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program. This would be a 75/25 cost share. The County's share would include any combination of cash or documented in-kind contributions to satisfy the match requirement. Commissioner Doty moved to participate in this grant. Commissioner Keith seconded the motion and a unanimous ballot was cast.

Gil Bates from Ida-Lew stopped in to update the Board.

Jeannette Dreadfulwater, Social Service Director, met to report on how the process seems to be working with the Department of Health and Welfare.
