They can have a usable disc available in two weeks so the County can access those older records and make copies when needed. Commissioner Keith moved to accept US Imaging's proposal for updating all the records for a cost of approximately \$30,000.00. This expense will be paid from the SRBA funds the county received. Commissioner Doty seconded the motion and a unanimous ballot was cast.
